Proactive Agenda



Funding:

- Funding Amount: In collaboration with the other Crime Victim Services coalitions, we have decided to request \$20 million from the state for Crime Victim Services this year, which is the equivalent to asking for \$40 million over the biennium.
- Minnesota Rehabilitation and Reinvestment Act: Shift the 25% cost savings from the MRRA from the general fund to crime victim services.



Survivor's Justice Act:

• Judges must consider a history of domestic violence when determining a sentence for a crime connected to that domestic violence, and this bill would allow people serving sentences for crimes they committed as a result of domestic abuse, sexual assault, or trafficking to apply to have their sentence reduced.



Advocate Confidentiality:

 Violence Free Minnesota wants to improve domestic violence advocate confidentiality to be an absolute, and not qualified, privilege on the same level as that afforded to sexual assault advocates.



Supportive Agenda



• **Statewide Forensics Coordinator:** We support the establishment of a Statewide Forensics Coordinator position in Minnesota, as well as any efforts to expand access, especially rural access, to Sexual Assault Nurse Examiners.



• **Disability and DV/SA Task Force:** VFMN supports the creation of a workgroup to assess the specific needs of disabled victim/survivors.



• Comprehensive Sex/Relationship Education: VFMN supports the creation and mandating of sex and relationship education for ages 10-18 which helps teach minors appropriate and healthy romantic relationship behaviors, as well as helps them identify when they may be in an unhealthy relationship.

Supportive Agenda



• **504b.206 Changes:** VFMN supports changes to Minn. Stat. 504B.206 which updates the language to allow for telehealth or virtual contact with medical providers or DV/SA advocates. VFMN further supports changes which limit the financial liability of survivors who utilize 504b.206.



• **North Star Act:** VFMN supports a bill to disentangle Minnesota Law Enforcement from ICE, which should enable undocumented victims to be more likely to seek help.



• Justice For All Coalition Proposals: As a member of the Justice For All Coalition's steering committee, VFMN supports all JFA recommended bills to bring about a safer and fairer Minnesota.
