THE COALITION TO END RELATIONSHIP ABUSE REMEMBERS **ALLISA MARIE VOLLAN** MINNESOTA'S 6TH CONFIRMED VICTIM OF INTIMATE PARTNER HOMICIDE IN 2024

Allisa Marie Vollan, 27, was killed in her boyfriend's home in Duluth on March 22, 2024. Her boyfriend Dale Howard, 25, is charged with two counts of second-degree murder, with one count citing his violation of a then-active no contact order. Further analysis regarding Allisa's cause of death is pending, although a preliminary report indicates that her injuries are potentially consistent with smothering.

Howard had previously been arrested and charged with domestic assault on March 9th after a neighbor reported him kicking Allisa in the head and slamming her head in the door. Allisa told officers on scene that day that Howard demonstrated jealousy over her past relationships, had previously been violent with her and had called her gendered slurs, and had previously threatened her about a dozen times. On March 12th a Domestic Abuse No Contact Order was issued, prohibiting Howard from having contact with Allisa. They had been dating for five months.

Allisa's family stated that she grew up in Duluth and graduated from Denfeld High School. Her family shared that she had "an abundance of great friends that stuck with her through life. She always looked forward to her next adventures and the new friends she could meet. She's loved and remembered by all of her family and friends."
