- The nominating party will be informed if their nomination has been selected for an award and **you** will be asked to attend Violence Free Minnesota's Annual Award Dinner on Wednesday September 8, 2021 to assist in presenting the award. We also would like the award recipient to attend the dinner as well.
- Awards will be given at Violence Free Minnesota's Annual Meeting/Awards Dinner on Wednesday, September 8, 2021. The Dinner/Annual Meeting will be held at Embassy Suites in Brooklyn Center, MN



AWARD CRITERIA

All Inspire Award nominees must be nominated by a Violence Free Minnesota member program. Each Inspire Award nominee should further the mission of your organization, as well as further the vision of Violence Free Minnesota. Please explain how your nominee contributes to and champions anti-oppression and anti-racism work, social norm change, economic justice, or betters their community.

Advocate Inspire Award

- Recipient must be an advocate of a Violence Free Minnesota member program
- Advocate should further anti-oppression work, social norm change, and/or economic justice
- Nominees provide outstanding advocacy to victim/survivors of relationship abuse, whether working directly with victim/survivors or advocating at a systems- or policy-level.
- Nominations of advocates newer to the work who have innovative and exciting ideas are welcomed

Community Leader Inspire Award

- Nominees may be a local activist, a faith leader, a teacher, a healer, a business, club or local
 organization -- any person or entity that works to improve their community and the liberation of
 victims and survivors.
- Nominee should not a paid staff or volunteer staff with a member agency.
- There is no requirement for any kind of formal work arrangement with a Violence Free Minnesota member program
- Community leader should contribute to anti-oppression work, social norm change, economic justice, and/or work to end relationship abuse in Minnesota and create safer and thriving communities

Volunteer Inspire Award

- "Volunteer" is a broad term: this person, agency, or organization may volunteer by offering probono services, including in the areas of advocacy, awareness, education, research and/or support.
- A volunteer whose work inspires survivors, staff, others in the community and helps form a foundation for the success of the work to end relationship abuse in Minnesota.
- Nominee must be a volunteer (not paid staff) with a Violence Free Minnesota member program
