

DOMESTIC VIOLENCE IS INTERSECTIONAL

EMPLOYMENT

In one study, 60% of the domestic violence survivors surveyed reported losing their jobs.

ECONOMIC JUSTICE

Nearly 3 out of 4 survivors of domestic abuse cite economic insecurity as the main reason they stayed with their abuser.

EDUCATION

If a classmate regularly experiences domestic violence, it impacts both the student experiencing the violence and how well the entire class performs.

HOMELESSNESS

As many as 57% of all homeless women report domestic violence as the immediate cause of their homelessness.

HEALTHCARE

Each year, 324,000 pregnant women experience domestic violence in the U.S. That makes abuse more common for pregnant women than gestational diabetes or pre-eclampsia.

NATURAL DISASTERS

Reports of domestic violence increased by 45% following Hurricane Katrina in 2005.

FOOD JUSTICE

Female-headed households in the U.S. have a food insecurity prevalence rate almost 3 times the national average.

ENVIRONMENT

High rates of sexual and domestic violence occur in Native communities where extraction industries are located.
